Boat registration is mandatory, because boats on the dam are often abandoned and the resulting congestion inhibits members from being able to launch boats, to fish, etc. **Please complete this form in full for the dam parking pass, even if you do not have a boat.**

In order to keep a boat on the dam, three criteria must be met:

- 1) Your membership dues are paid and current
- 2) You have successfully completed this form
- 3) You have affixed your registration sticker to the bow (front) of your boat.

Once the first two criteria have been met, you will be issued a Walnut Hill Country Club registration sticker to affix to the bow of your boat. The sticker can be picked up at Bunny Cocula's house (at the corner of Valley Dr. and Rt. 517) along with the dam parking pass.
